No Sawdust?

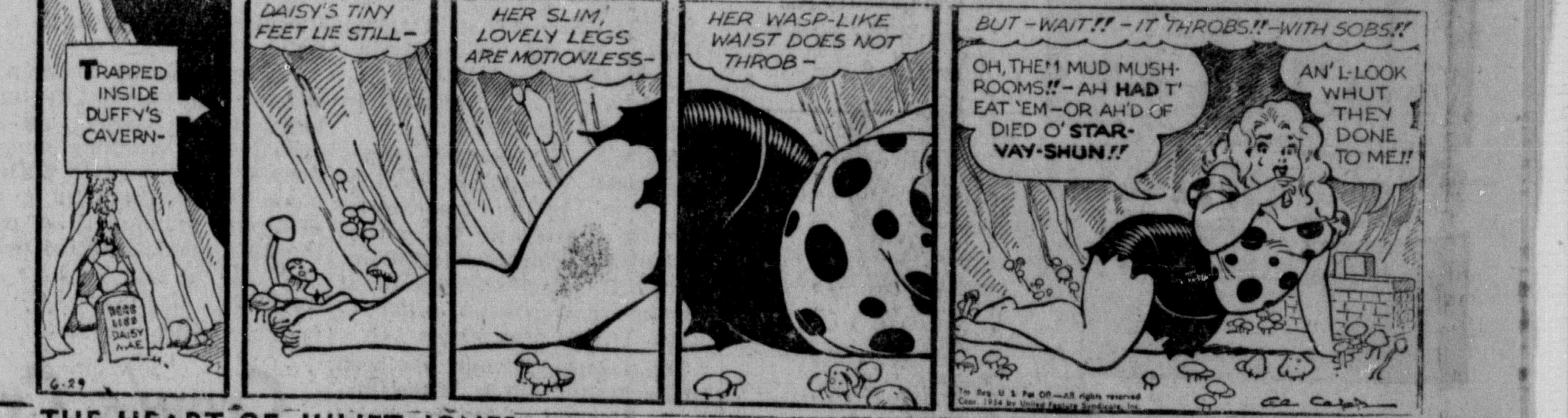
