

Since she needed two entries to dummy for leads up to her hearts, she should have led a spade first, to dummy's seven. After that lost to the king, the eight and the jack would be the entries she wanted.

Seeing her mistake at once she saw another chance. If Mr. Abel had a doubleton honor in hearts or if Mr. Champion had both king and queen of hearts and she could guess which was the true situation, she could make her contract with only one heart lead from the board. There was also the chance if Mr. Abel had a doubleton honor in hearts, he might go in with his honor prematurely thus taking out the guess.
