

Arctic Study To Continue This Summer

MONTREAL (CP)—Col. P. D. (Pat) Baird, one of Canada's top explorers, plans to resume his study of the Arctic this summer on lonely Baffin Island.

He will head a 13-man group of Canadian, British and Swiss experts and university undergraduates to the Arctic outpost. The group will make its headquarters at Pangnirtung and branch out from there in search of scientific data on conditions in the Arctic.

The expedition, sponsored by the Arctic Institute of North America and the Swiss Foundation for Alpine Research, leaves Dorval airport May 15. Col. Baird will act as leader and glaciologist.

W. H. Ward of the United Kingdom Department of Scientific and Industrial Research will join the expedition as a glaciologist.

A total of 12 tons of supplies were sent to Pangnirtung last fall and stored there. Still to go is a ton of scientific equipment. The party will fly by RCAF to Frobisher Bay, and then to Pangnirtung.

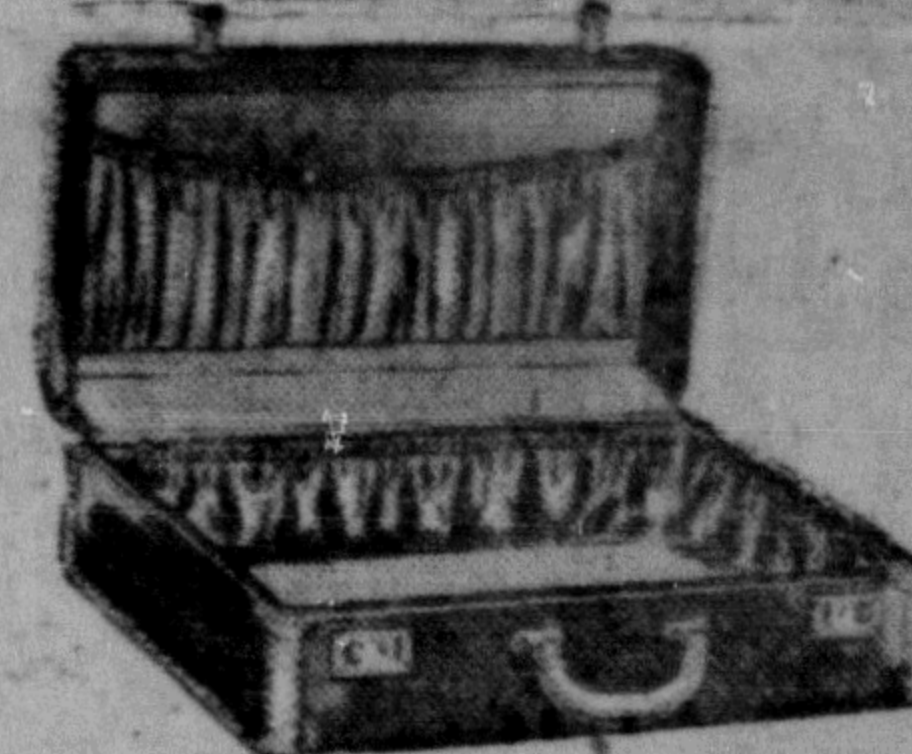

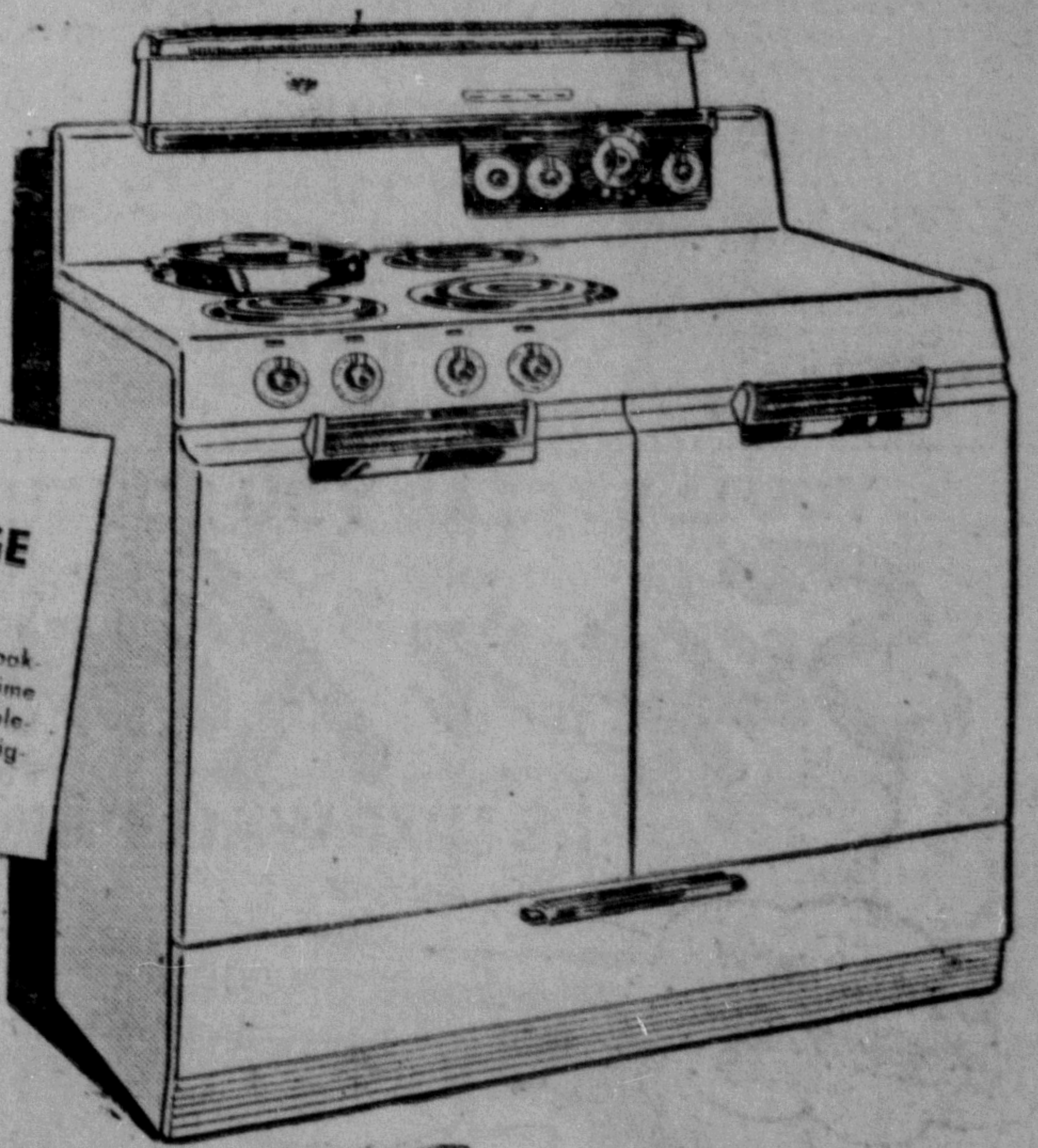
