Sealed tenders addressed to the Chief Supervisor of Fisheries, 1110 West Georgia Street, Vancouver, B.C., and endorsed on the outside of the envelope "Tender for the construction of fishway at Kajusdis Falls" will be received up to noon of the 2nd day of July 1954, for the construction of a fishway on the Kajusdis River about four miles from Bella Bella, B.C.

The work consists of the excavation of approximately 140 cubic yards of solid rock, all open cut, and the construction of twelve reinforced concrete baffle requiring placement of approximately four cubic yards of concrete.

Tenders will not be considered unless made on the form supplied by the Department of Fisheries and in accordance with the conditions set forth therein, and no tender will be considered for only a part of the work.
