 —but unhappily for any progress  
 towards the solution of the Sen-  
 ate problem—Mr. Drew did not  
 win the election. Mr. St. Laurent  
 is still faced, therefore, with the  
 brain-teaser of knowing what to  
 do with a state of affairs which  
 he publicly has recognized as  
 contrary to public and parlia-  
 mentary interests.  
 The Conservatives naturally  
 say that the Prime Minister  
 could remedy the situation read-  
 ily enough by appointing Con-  
 servatives to fill existing vacan-  
 cies. But other opposition par-  
 ties as well as a substantial body  
 of impartial political opinion in  
 the Capital question the moral  
 right—let alone any obligation—  
 on Mr. St. Laurent's part to name  
 representatives of a political  
 party which has been so over-  
 whelmingly rejected by the pub-  
 lic in democratic process.  
 The rumor persists that the  
 Prime Minister intends to follow  
 a middle course by naming Sen-  
 ators whose reputation is inde-  
 pendent rather than political.  
 The name of John Bracken, who  
 managed to combine Liberal and  
 Progressive as well as Conserva-  
 tive ingredients in his some-  
 what unusual political career is  
 mentioned commonly as likely to  
 be the first of the new-type Sen-  
 ators. If such an appointment  
 materializes, it is assured of a  
 mixed and controversial recep-  
 tion in political circles here.
