Tass Reporter Debarred By Gallery

OTTAWA —The parliamentary press gallery has rejected the application of Tass, official Russian news agency, for membership in the gallery for Ivan Tsvetkov.

A statement issued by gallery president Robert Needham, Ottawa representative of the London, Ont., Free Press, said:

"The Canadian parliamentary press gallery voted to reject the membership application submitted by Tass news agency in behalf of Ivan Tsvetkov, to succeed Arcadi Ogorodnikov.

"This application was rejected on the grounds that Mr. Tsvetkov is an official of a Soviet government agency and attached to the Soviet embassy in Ottawa.

"The gallery's decision, therefore, is based on an objection to Mr. Tsvetkov's direct association with the embassy which leaves his status as a newspaperman in doubt."

Effect of the ruling by the 72-member gallery is that the Tass representative is debarred from such privileges as a seat in the press sections overlooking the Commons and Senate and desk space in the gallery quarters in the centre block of Parliament. He also would not be allowed to attend the press conferences restricted to gallery members.

However, no restraint is imposed on the filing of dispatches from Ottawa to Moscow.

The rejection of the application on behalf of Mr. Tsvetkov leaves Tass without representation in the gallery. He was to have succeeded Mr. Ogorodnikov, recently recalled to Moscow.

Higher Price Demanded

WASHINGTON (Reuters) — Canada, Australia and the United States have presented an ultimatum in negotiations for a new international wheat agreement.

Major exporters under the present agreement, they have proposed that negotiations, begun seven weeks ago, be abandoned unless the importing countries agree to a higher price.

Most observers here are reported to believe that negotiations will collapse unless importing countries alter their stand on the price issue.

Delegates represent the 46 member nations of the agreement which expires July 31.

The importing countries, including Britain, have refused in negotiations thus far to agree to an increase of more than 15 cents in the present price of \$1.80 a bushel.

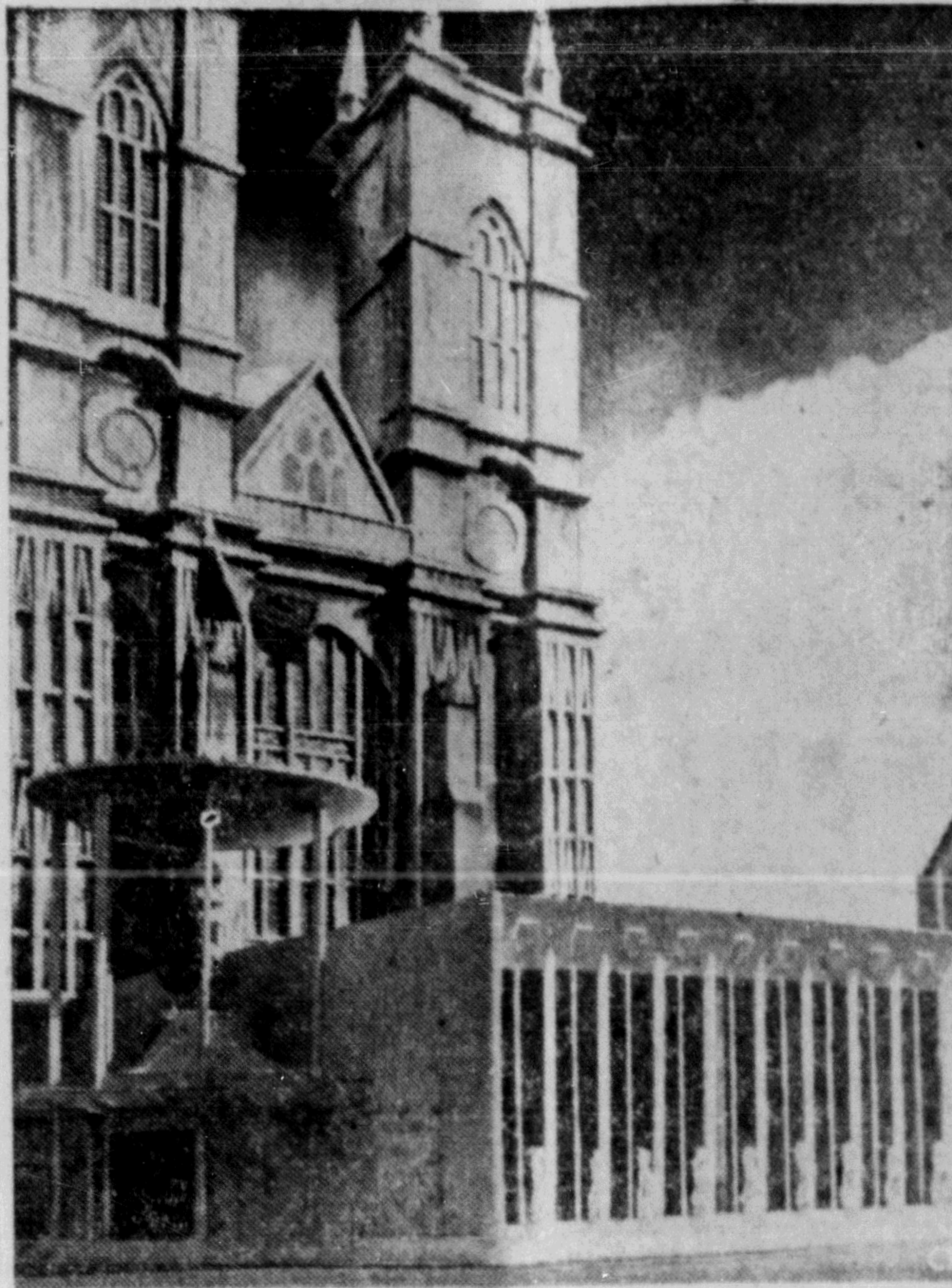
Canada, Australia and the U.S. are demanding an increase of 30 cents, to \$2.10 a bushel. The price dispute has deadlocked negotiations for weeks.

Agree to Exchange Plan

VANCOUVER —University of British Columbia students are willing to put up the money to bring a Russian exchange student here to study for one year.

A majority of students who voted in a referendum on the plan approved addition of 20 cents to the fees of each student to pay for the exchange, in which a UBC student would study at a Russian university.

The exchange plan had threatened to break up the National Federation of Canadian University Students. At the last NFCUS conference, Quebec universities said they would withdraw from the federation if the plan were approved. The federation decided to let individual colleges work out their own plans.

Next problem: To find a Russian student who can come to Canada and a Russian university which will take a UBC student.

Prince George Starts Cruises At End of May

VANCOUVER —B.C.'s popular summer cruise ship, the Prince George, will make 11 round voyages between Vancouver and Alaskan ports during this summer's cruise season. A. C. L. Warner, general passenger agent, B.C. district, Canadian National Railways, announced.

Instead of the usual eight scheduled cruises, the George will make nine this year, starting June 9. She will also make two charter runs, to open and close the season.

From May 31 to June 8 she will carry members of the United States National Presbyterian Council of Missions on a voyage to Sitka, old Russian capital of Alaska.

On her last voyage of the cruise season, the George has been chartered by Shriners from the Al Malaika Temple, Los Angeles, for a 10-day cruise to Skagway and return, leaving Vancouver on September 11.

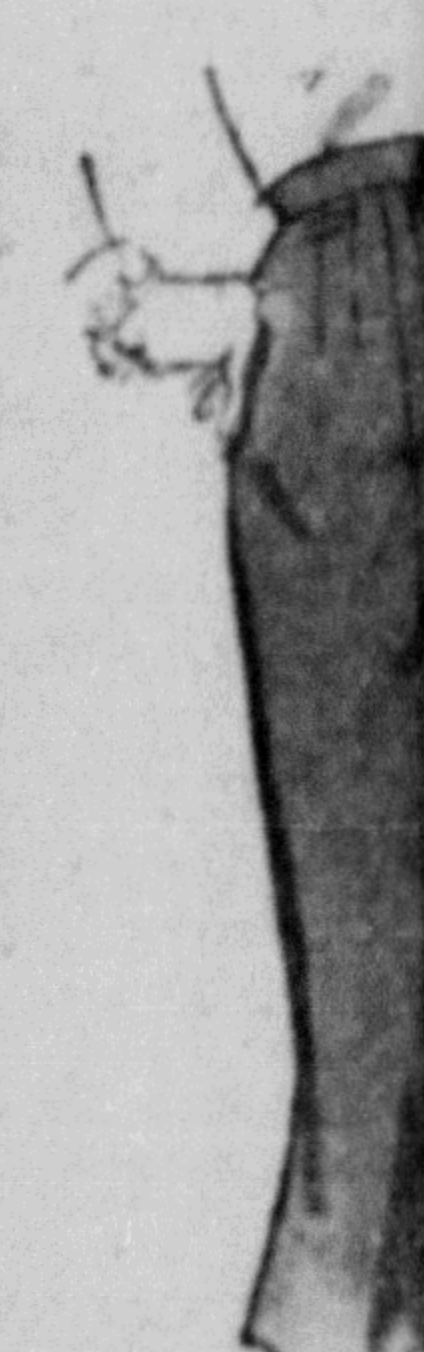
