**Charge Faces Total of 12**

Charging in police court of Mike Postuk and James Slack with being members of an unlawful assembly brought to 12 the number of persons facing this charge as a result of the downtown disturbance in front of the city hall early last Sunday morning.

The 12, which included nine whites and three natives, also includes two juvenile girls who in court Thursday gave their names as Nancy Conrod and Diane Miller of Nanaimo. The pair, who are free on \$150 bail, also stated that they were 18 years old. Misses Conrod and Miller are reported to be still in Nanaimo.

In court this morning Richard Clarkson, of Nanaimo, pleaded guilty to a charge of theft of goods valued at \$25, was sentenced by Magistrate Vance to \$50 fine, costs or one month.
