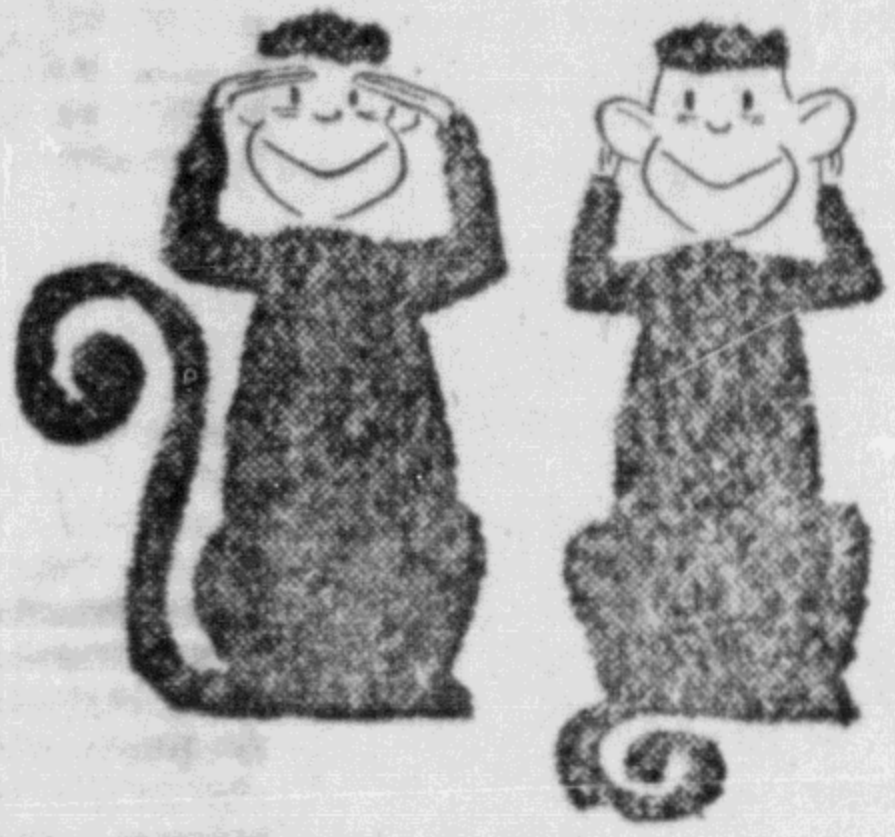

Kiner Showing
"Old Form"
In Exhibitions

MESA, Ariz. (AP)—Ralph Kiner of Chicago Cubs gives every indication of a young man who hopes to regain the home run championship of the National League and of re-establishing his claim as an all-round baseball player.
Hit bat sank New York Giants Wednesday for their fourth straight defeat, 10-7, with a performance that started with a two-run homer his first time at bat and a grand-slammer later in the game.
In five exhibitions to date, Kiner is hitting well over .500. He has three home runs and has driven in 10 runs.
Kiner reported to camp weighing 190 pounds, seven less than when he finished the long grind last year and 10 or 15 pounds under the figure he carried last spring into the quarters of his former employers, Pittsburgh Pirates.
The general impression is that Kiner had a "bad year" in 1953, though many a club would like more "bad" years from a guy who belted 25 home runs, drove in 116, hit a creditable .279 and had a fielding average of .973.
But not written in the records are the facts that Kiner in 1953 played under the handicap of a groin injury and got off to a poor and late start because of a row initiated by his boss then, Branch Rickey, Sr.
The Rickey mess is past history and Kiner is happy to be with Chicago.
Kiner was home-run king of the National League for seven straight years until Milwaukee's Eddie Matthews dethroned him last season.

This One Still Has Mr. Muzzy Stumped

Mr. Muzzy is still trying to figure out how Mr. Masters got away without losing a diamond trick on this hand. As a matter of fact it isn't too easy to see, even looking at all the cards.

Mr. Masters bid his hand strongly, knowing that cautious Mr. Meek probably had something in reserve for his club side. On the second round Mr. Meek quickly got out of the no-trump department but not to be denied, Mr. Masters went on to game at clubs.

Mr. Muzzy led the jack of spades and Mr. Masters carefully refrained from covering with dummy's queen. The reason was that he placed the king on his right and wanted to throw Mrs. Keen in at the proper time for a diamond return.

Winning the first trick with the ace of spades, he cashed the ace of hearts and ruffed a heart on the board. He then led a club to his ace and learned that he had a loser in that suit when Mrs. Keen discarded a small spade.

He ruffed his last heart and led a spade. Mrs. Keen was in with the king and if she returned a spade or a heart, Mr. Masters would ruff in dummy while discarding a diamond loser from his hand. Therefore she led back a diamond, selecting the nine, although any diamond would have brought the same final result.

Arrow Lakes
Power Project
Being Studied

SPOKANE (AP)—Kaiser Aluminum and Chemical Corp. may construct a water power project in British Columbia to help firm up its supply of electricity during low water periods, a company spokesman said Tuesday.
Norman L. Krey, manager for the company's Northwest operations, said the company has been studying data on available sites and has had discussions with both Canadian authorities and Bonneville Power Administration officials on the subject.
Kaiser engineers will start preliminary field surveys for a possible water storage dam on lower Arrow Lake, north of Castlegar, within the next few weeks, he said.
