## School Tenders Too High

Tenders for the new Port Edward elementary school were too high, District 52 school board decided at its last meeting.

The low bid, that of Fraser Valley Builders Ltd., Terrace, of \$157,624 has been referred to architects Sharp, Thompson, Berwick and Pratt who will confer with the contractors to scale down the plans until they are within the \$146,660 allowed for in the bylaw.

A six-room school with activity room is planned. Other contractors bidding for the job were Northwest Construction, \$195,442 and Mitchell and Currie, \$165,758.

Maintenance work has been carried on at most schools during the summer with two classrooms at Borden Street school and two at Conrad Street school being re-decorated; new floors

put in the Conrad Street school basement; a new roof on the Seal Cove school and painting and redecoration carried out at Sunnyside school.

The school board also passed for payment bills totalling \$12,677.
