prices is acknowledged to be the current high level of taxation. But whenever lower taxation is talked in the Commons, the government comes up with the answer that, while its desirability is in no sense disputed, it is practically impossible, in view of the nation's international and military commitments. With the lengthening shadow of Indo-China events, the realization is growing in Parliament that Canada's existing commitments in the international field are right up to the limit of what the nation can afford, if indeed, they have not already passed that point. For that reason, Canada's Geneva delegation is likely to spend much of its time on the sidelines.

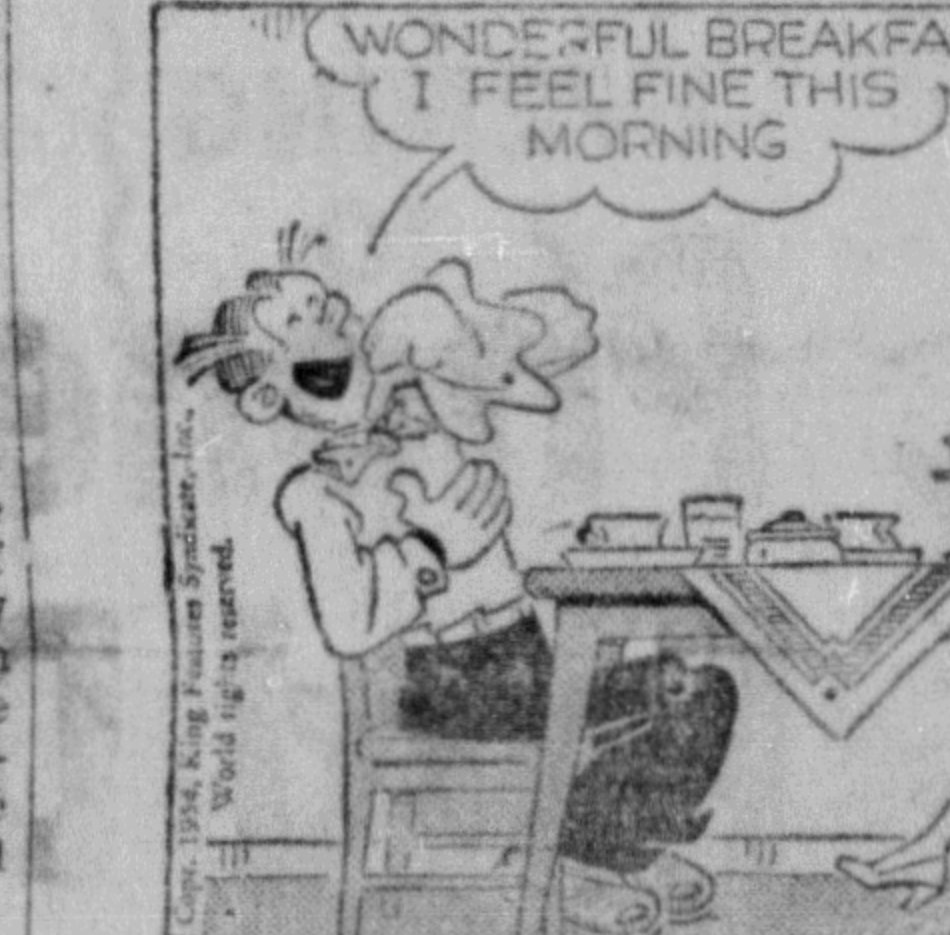

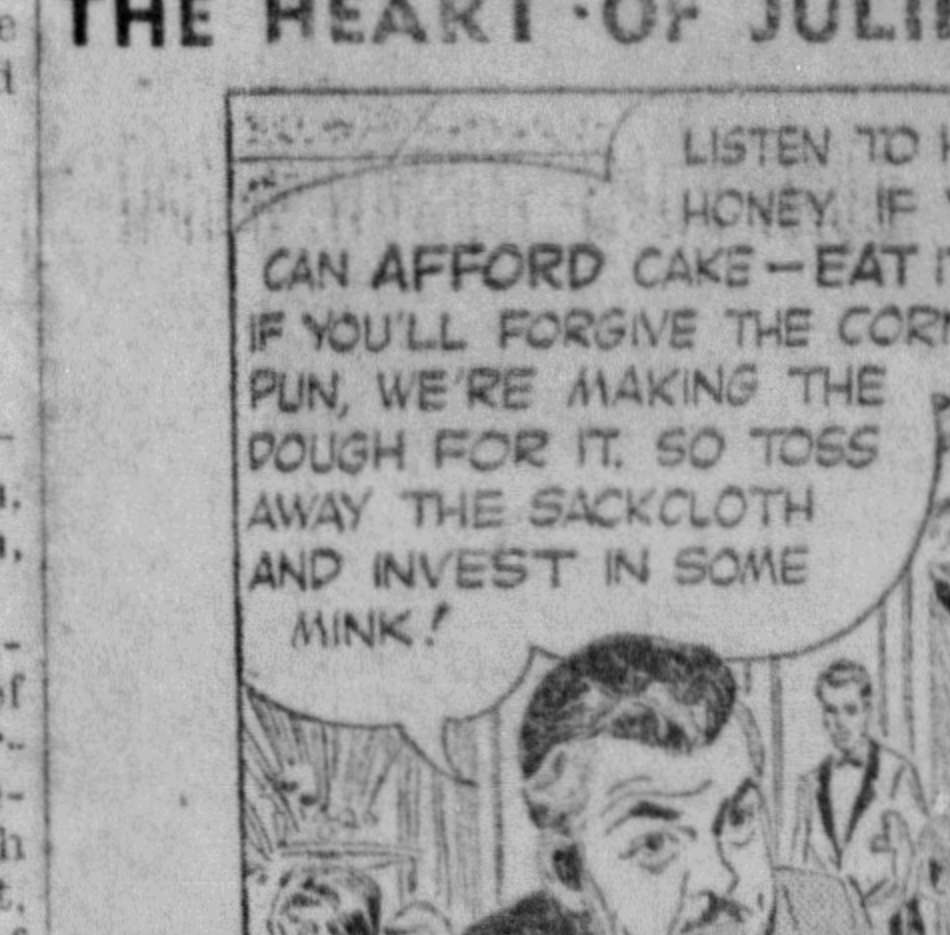

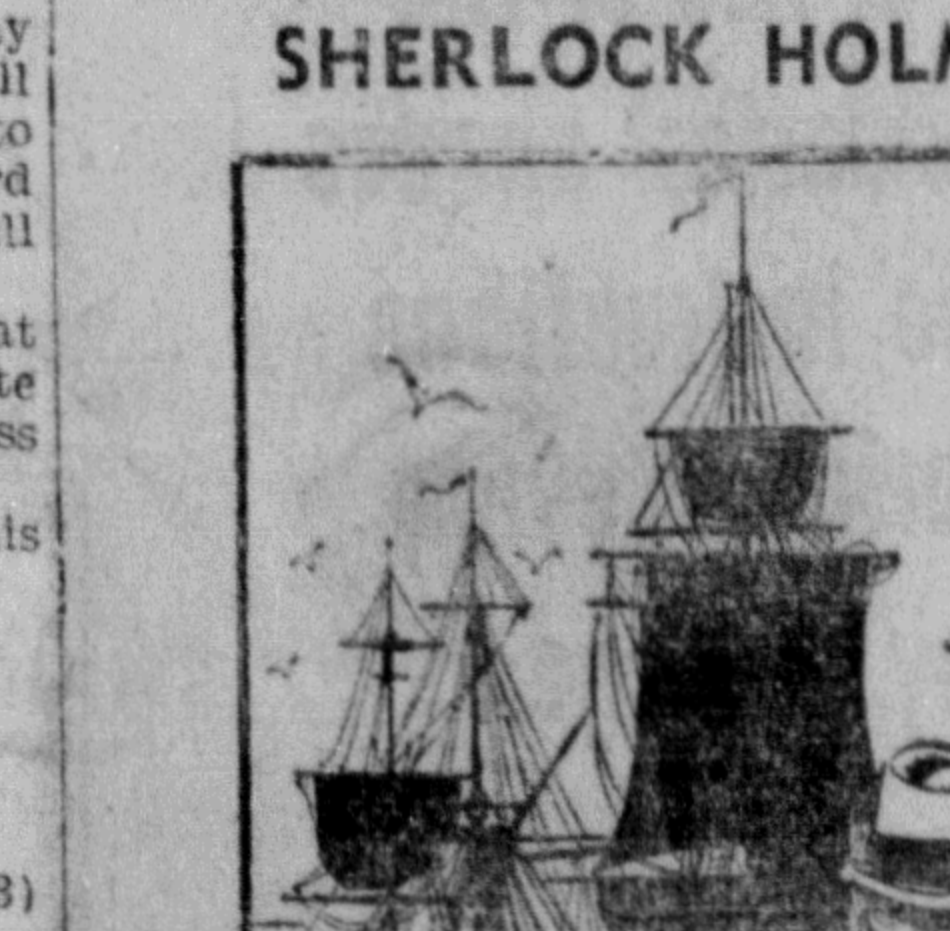
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
