Jobs Vanish If Profits Taxed Heavily

QUEBEC (CP)—Business dies and jobs disappear without profits, or when profits are taxed too much, J. D. Ferguson of Rock Island, Que. president of the Canadian Manufacturers' Association said this week.

In an address to the Quebec City branch of the CMA, he said:

"If an industry does not make a profit its energy is sapped; its efficiency lags; its productivity stops; it goes out of business. Its workers join the unemployed."

"As a matter of fact, profits are necessary to the maintenance of big government which seems to have become an accepted way of life in Canada. Without profits, which governments tax to the tune of 50 per cent, governments would be in a difficult position."

"The systematic siphoning-off of profits by a so-called 'suitable taxation' plan drawn up by governments bent on spending so-called benefits, hits hardest in the long run at the working man himself."
