FLOOD RELIEF

we had our birthday. It is a terrible mixup here right now. You can hardly imagine. Everyone is downhearted and out of the ordinary. Our town (Ureth) is empty. This afternoon I did some shopping. We were with about 20 people in the Galeries Modernes (big warehouse).

"The radio gives only funeral music, interrupted with messages about air-droppings and rescues, and with requests for help from the flooded areas from where they are only able to send emergency messages by means of the radio.

"It is getting worse and worse. This morning the dykes at Schouwen gave way in three more places and on February 16 there will be high tide again, so they are working like mad to repair whatever possible, otherwise it will still be worse.

"Uncle Bas, Dad's youngest brother perished. His hands were home when the floods set upon them. He struggled the whole night, up to his waist in the water, to loosen the cattle. Then the water rose very fast at once and he had to flee along the dyke which gave way just behind him. He made it up to Strijen where Uncle Smits lives. There he died, most likely of a heart attack.

The letter goes on to tell of other families in similar plight.

"We have an idea how these people are suffering, because we know the country," said Mr. Scholten. "My family is only one of thousands."

The campaign here winds up Saturday with a sale of home cooking and will be served by women dressed in the national costume of the Netherlands.

The sale will be held at the former Bulkley Market store on Third Avenue which has been decorated with windmills and wooden shoes.

Of particular help in canvassing have been two city organizations of young people, Job's Daughters in charge of Mrs. Alex Mitchell and the Catholic Youth Organization, in charge of Martin Nuyten.

Several individuals also have volunteered for the work. The entire city is expected to be covered by tonight.
