Claims He Killed
Under Orders

KLAGENFURT, Austria (CP)—
A 29-year-old Yugoslav has
claimed he acted under British
secret service orders in the mur-
der of Mrs. Simone de Ridder of
Belgium on the Vienna-Ostend
express 10 days ago, police said
today.

The police statement said the
Yugoslav, Stefan Matusevic, "con-
fessed to the broad outlines"
of the killing, but laid the main
blame on an unnamed accom-
plice. He is demanding to be
taken to British intelligence of-
ficers on whose "secret instruc-
tions" he acted, the statement
said.

Mrs. de Ridder, 51, was the
mother of Olympic skating star
Micheline Lannoy. She was
pushed off the express near
Kitzingen, Bavaria.
