Free Trip to Italy Prize For Elder Essay Writers

Want a free trip to Italy? You can have one if you're over 18, and can write a prize-winning essay on "Why I Wish to Visit Italy."

The Italian State Tourist Office, under the patronage of the Italian Embassy in Canada, is staging an essay contest in Canada and offering a round trip by ocean liner and a round-trip by plane to Rome, with tours of Italian cities and so on as the two first prizes.

Second prize is a 50 per cent reduction on the cost of a tourist class round-trip ticket to Rome on an ocean liner, plus tours, and third prize is a selection of artistic publications on Italy. The contest, designed to promote relations between Italy and Canada, is open to all Canadian citizens over 18 years of age. The essay, to contain between 300 and 1,000 words, may be written in French or English, and must be typewritten and double spaced.

Each essay must be signed with a pseudonym only. The name, address and age of the entrant must be recorded on a separate sheet, placed in a sealed envelope and attached to the essay.

Entries must be submitted not

later than May 29, 1954, to the Italian State Tourist Office, International Aviation Building, 1080 University Street, Montreal, P.Q.

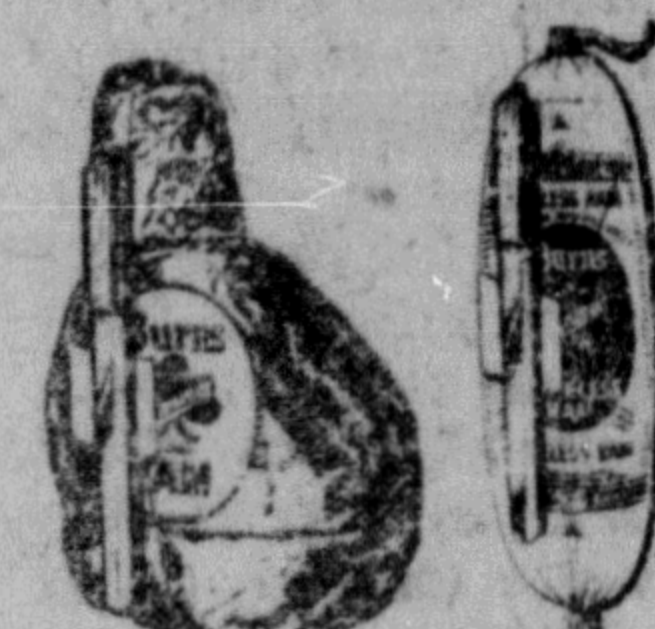
