Chief Electoral Officer advised that to print the necessary papers to hold by-elections, if any by-elections should be necessary, would take approximately six months, particularly as they would have to be printed for an election in any possible place, and there might be occasions when it would be desirable to have by-elections within six months.

Pickersgill had pointed out to the Electoral Officer that surely if that occasion arose and Parliament was in session, we could pass a special act to validate the use of the old papers. However, what we have done now is pass a general Act making all such material usable until the next general election.
