

### Spread Fertilizer By Air Method

LONDON (CP) - Use of RAF planes and training crew to help Britain produce more food was visualized as a possibility during a recent debate on agriculture in the House of Lords. It was suggested the planes could be used to advantage in spraying fertilizer from the air over hilly farmlands and other areas difficult to fertilize by normal means.

## South Africa Trout Paradise

NEW YORK (AP)-How would you like to catch a 14-pound rainbow trout?

Harold McCracken, noted hunter, fisherman and author, has just returned from South America and says the world's best trout fishing is to be found in the Chilean lake regions near the Pacific coast.

He says 14-pound rainbows and browns are commonplace, 16-pounders not rare and 20pounders reported.

The day before McCracken left the area on his return to the United States he and two companions fished from the same rowboat and in less than three hours hooked 17 trout totalling slightly more than 90 pounds. Six of the beauties weighed more than 61/2 pounds

McCracken says the lakes originally were stocked in 1905 by fingerlings brought from Germany. Then the area was forgotten. In 1928 a Briton, who planned to build a ranch in the area, restocked some of the lakes with fish imported from New Jersey.

The next winter the Briton died and the area again was more-or-less forgotten, fishwise. McCracken says the fishing paradise extends for 400 miles | Third Avenue

through the centre of Chile,

paralleling the High Andes. "The water is cold, mostly crystal clear, and in most of the streams it runs fast with many white water rapids. There probably is no other area on earth which offers such ideal and expansive a habitat for trout, says-McCracken, wno found the lake while on a moving-picture

## Parents Often Bad Examples

WINNIPEG (CP) - A Winnipeg judge says there are too many homes in which parents, while "preaching little sermons on what is right and wrong" nevertheless set examples which tend to make liars and thieves out of the children.

Judge Emerson J. Heaney says boys and girls always watch the example set by adults. "How many parents have crossed the international border and not declared everything to the cust toms?" he asked. "How many have filed income tax returns and cut corners? or used old street-car transfers instead of putting a dime in the box?"

These may be commonplace things, but children watch every move, he said. "As children are trained, so they will act."

Judge Heaney cites as an example the mother who tells her daughter, "Let's keep this a secret from your father." when she does something which her husband will not approve.

"That mother is training her daughter to deceive her future husband," the judge says.

Young people are quick to recognize the insincerity of adults. "It is not what you say, but what you do that counts. What you do makes so much noise that young people can't hear what you say.
