## BLACKWOOD on *Bridge*

You Have to Overbid  
With Meek as Partner.

When you have Mr. Meek for a partner, the danger of getting too high and suffering a nasty penalty is slight indeed. That's good.

On the bad side, however, is the fact you may miss a lay-down game or slam through your partner's timidity.

You can offset this weakness, but it is a delicate job. You can and should take the bullish course in a close situation. On the other hand, you should never go too far in that direction—that is, far enough so it is obvious to Mr. Meek you are overbidding your hand to make up for his conservatism. That would only result in his tightening up all the more.

Note how Mr. Dale handled Mr. Meek in today's deal. The purist will be horrified at his two no trump rebid. He lacks the high card strength for that call and has no semblance of a stopper in the heart suit. He considered the alternative rebid of three clubs—also a slight overbid. And then there was the extremely conservative rebid of two clubs. He knew Mr. Meek would pass this latter bid, even with a pretty fair hand.

All in all it appeared to Mr. Dale the two no trump rebid would be most likely to pry another bid out of his partner. On his actual holding it is probable Mr. Meek would have passed a three club rebid.

He wouldn't rebid his anemic suit, he had no diamond stopper for no trump and the thought of reaching all the way to five clubs would make him shudder. As it was, however, he was glad to go on to three no trump over his partner's two no trump bid.

Mr. Champion opened the 10 of hearts and Mr. Dale had to make the key play here at trick one. He did. He disdained the finesse and went right in with the ace.

He led the jack of clubs and let it ride. Mr. Champion won with the king and returned a heart. But Mr. Dale had another heart stopper in dummy's jack. The defenders took two

diamond tricks but then Mr. Dale had the rest.

Note if Mr. Dale had ducked the first heart lead, the opponents could have won two diamonds, led a third diamond to clear the suit and then Mr. Champion could have cashed his last diamond when on lead with the king of clubs.

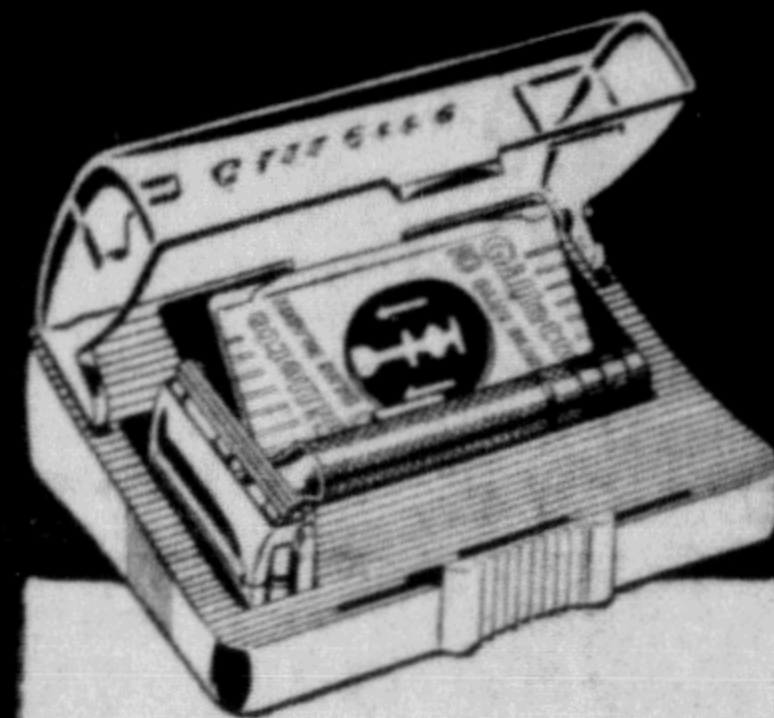
