McGregor said unoccupied space in the modern fighter is so limited it seemed nothing could be added as far "plumbing and wiring" were

concerned. It was hard for layman to believe that a reasonable degree of serviceability could be obtained under operational conditions in such a "can of worms" and it was even harder to believe that any country could make good the wastage in war of such a


