Doctors May Use Unclaimed Bodies

VICTORIA (CP) Unclaimed and unidentified bodies may be used by doctors and medical students for anatomical studies under provisions of a bill introduced in the British Columbia leg-

The bill provides that a corpse unclaimed within three months could be turned over to the University of British Columbia medical school or some other recognized school or to a qualified medical practitioner. The bodies would include those

found publicly exposed or which would have to be buried at public expense or of persons who were supported by a public institution immediately before If the body is not claimed

within 48 hours of death, it would be placed under the control of the deputy minister of health and remain under that control for three months or until it is claimed. After three months, the depu-
