With distributional advantages, you need less in high cards. Take today's hand, for example. Each side can make game at its best suit and yet each side has just about half the high cards.

As you see, East-West can make five hearts but Mr. Meek didn't like the vulnerability of the hand and besides he thought there was a chance to defeat four spades.

Mr. Champion made his contract by careful counting. Mr. Abel opened the deuce of hearts and Mr. Champion immediately figured him for either three hearts to an honor or four small ones. Then 10 was played from dummy and Mr. Meek won with the queen. The ace of hearts was returned and Mr. Champion ruffed.

It was clear that Mr. Abel had started with four hearts as all the honors had shown up in the other three hands. The king of spades was laid down and Mr. Abel won with the ace and got out with a spade.

Mr. Champion won with dummy's queen and led a club. Mr. Meek went right in with the ace and led back the jack. The king of clubs won and Mr. Champion now ruffed his last club on the board.

On this last trick Mr. Meek showed out, discarding a heart. The count on the hand was now clear. Mr. Meek had shown up with exactly one spade and two clubs. By inference he could be figured for six hearts. Therefore he must have started with four diamonds. And that meant Mr. Abel had a singleton diamond.

So Mr. Champion cashed the king of diamonds, led a small diamond and finessed the nine with every confidence. He was able to enter dummy with a trump to lead another diamond and finess the jack. Thus the defenders were held to just three tricks, the aces of spades, hearts and clubs.
