

LONDON (Reuters) - Commonwealth finance ministers are expected to hold another conference on the problems of the sterling area towards the end of this year, an authorifative source says here.

The source said dates and revenue are still unsettled, but consultations on these questions are taking place among Commonwealth capitals.

Richard Butler, British treasury chief, hopes the Commonwealth ministers will be able to meet before the end of 1953 to review progress made since the last economic conference in London in November and De-




