The Felton exclusion is too much like McCarthy and McCarry for me.
I, FOR ONE, have never believed in the suicidal doctrine that even if it is shown in future that Communism is, as some charge, a "world conspiracy" working to take away all freedom from everybody, that it should be allowed to operate as a lawful democratic party. If I were ever convinced of that I would certainly be in favor of its dissolution, by Parliament. But unless and until that happens, I am all for the good old British system of live-and-let-live. Let everybody come and go as he pleases. Let him write or say what he chooses—and only get in trouble if he says or writes something unlawful.

Mr. New Talks a Perfect Game—Plays a Poor One
Mr. New, the avid kibitzer, talks a great game. He is very glib about coups, squeezes and end-plays. He can give you the standard safety play for every combination of cards. In short, he can do everything but play the game.

In today's deal he proved there is such a thing as being too safe. Mrs. Keen led the queen of hearts. Mr. New decided to use the hold-up play and he let the queen win. A heart was continued and taken by dummy's ace. At this point Mr. New took stock and saw that if he could take four tricks in clubs he could win nine tricks without having to try the dangerous spade finesse. Of course, there was the little matter of keeping Mrs. Keen out of the lead, but Mr. New was so obsessed with his knowledge of how to safety-play clubs that he gave no thought to this danger. At trick three he cashed the ace of clubs and then led the deuce. If Mr. Dale had played low, he intended to put in the nine. The nine would either hold the trick or, if it lost, the opposing clubs would be divided 3-2, the most favorable division. If Mr. Dale played the 10 on the second club lead, Mr. New planned to win it with the king and fire back the nine, which would drive out the queen. Either way, he thought, four clubs could be won.

He had used the standard safety play for this combination of cards, all right, but see what happened. On the second club lead, Mr. Dale played the 10. Mr. New won with the king and played back the nine, remarking complacently that Mr. Dale could take his queen any time he wanted. Mr. Dale replied that if no one objected, he believed he'd make it later. He ducked and let the nine win. It slowly dawned on Mr. New that he still didn't have clubs set up and that he needed two entries to dummy to do the job. He had just one—the ace of diamonds. Desperately, he went to the board with that card and took the spade finesse. Down he went.
