Apparently a diamond lead could gain nothing. It was likey that diamonds would be dummy's shortest suit. As to hearts, Mr. Meek had the top hree cards in the suit and, it the defenders had a heart win-That is, since Mr. Meek had a rick in both diamonds and clubs, there was no chance of Miss Brash running away with

he hand. Meek led the trey of that suit Mr. Abel's queen forced the ace. Miss Brash laid down the ace of diamonds and followed with he queen. Mr. Meek won with


