

Americans 'Support' Free Trade

VANCOUVER (CP)—The president of the Canadian Chamber of Commerce, concluding a tour from the Atlantic to the Pacific, says he found faith in a continued high level of prosperity throughout the country.

L. W. Simms of Lancaster, N.B., in the midst of a swing through British Columbia, had encouraging words for the province's big base metal mining industry when he said protectionists in the United States were fighting a rearguard action.

He expressed full confidence that the "strong sentiment in the U.S. against high tariffs will prevail."

Fresh from a meeting of the American Chamber of Commerce in Washington, Mr. Simms said discussion there indicated full business support for free trade.

Congressmen in favor of maintaining trade restrictions were a "loud minority" but it was evident that the administration plans to fight impediments in world commerce.

The subject of Mr. Simms's remarks also became a topic of discussion at the Pacific Northwest Trade Association meeting in Tacoma, Wash., recently.

The association passed a resolution expressing concern over a balance of trade unfavorable to Canada. In a separate resolution, it also advocated two-nation development of Canada's gas resources and opposed a proposed bill in Congress that would restrict the piping of gas across the border.

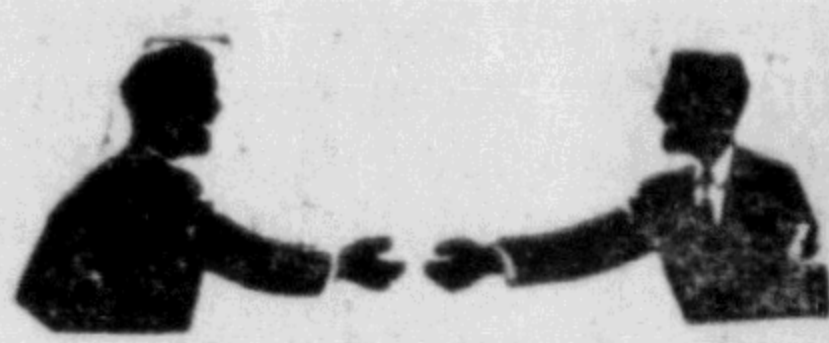
