## Quebec Develops Big 'Boys' Town'

MONTREAL (C)—There's a town planning scheme afoot for Canada's first "boys' town."

With the extension of the Boscoville Youth Protection School, which will be completed shortly, judges before whom teen-agers are brought should have fewer dilemmas.

For 12 years the founder, Rev. Albert Roger, has been working with small groups of boys, first at a centre at Lac des Francais north of Joliette, Que., and for the last five years at Riviere des Prairies in northern Montreal.

His scheme aims at the rehabilitation of older teen-agers based on self-government and the development of personal responsibility. The Quebec government has recognized the value of the experiment and the good results obtained with average boys referred to it by the social welfare court.

Final plans are still under consideration but the expansion will probably provide facilities for some 150 "citizens," compared with the present 20 or 30. Up to now the welfare court has had to refer many of the more serious juvenile cases to criminal court.

The usual age for reference to Boscoville is 16, and no fixed term of admission is specified. In practice, the minimum stay is about three years.

Practically every citizen of the boys' town has reacted well to the opportunity to develop his own sense of responsibility. There have been only two recorded exceptions. The idea is that once a boy has proved he is

a good citizen of Boscoville he is likely to be a good citizen anywhere. One youth is a strong candidate for a place in one of Canada's crack military colleges.

Father Rogers says he never anticipated such a career when he was studying for the priesthood. One of the determining influences was the success of Father Flanagan's experiment in New York State.
