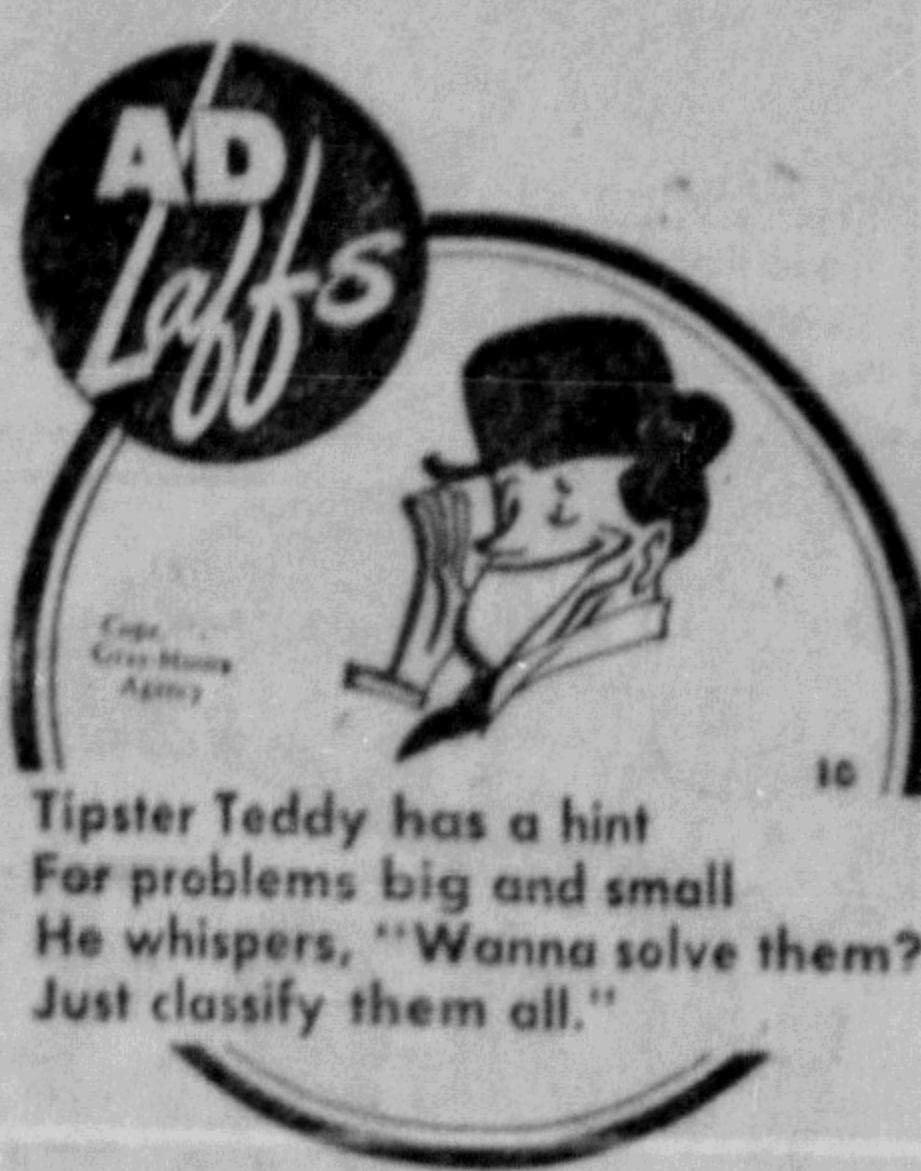

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Simpson's Sales Up 8 Per Cent In First Quarter

TORONTO (CP)—E. G. Burton, president of Simpson's, Ltd., said "further important cuts in corporation taxes" would give companies such as Simpson's a "real incentive to expand, thus contributing to a high level of employment."

Merchandising in Canada's rapidly-expanding economy, he said, calls for large sums of money to finance continuing improvement and expansion if a company is to hold and improve its position. Expansion in the country's national income should enable tax cuts to be made.

Mr. Burton said first-quarter sales in the company's five department stores increased by eight per cent over last year. However, it would require a strong merchandise and sales program in the summer and fall months to meet last year's figures, which benefited by the lifting of credit restrictions last May.
