

an's 1st Lady Diplomat End of Moslem "Purdah"

Pakistan (Reuters) — In 1950, the begum and her husband left their two sons, Ashraf, now 17; and Akbar, now 9, in the care of the English nurse and went to visit Canada and the United States.

This was a year before the prime minister was assassinated while addressing a meeting of Moslems in October, 1951.

The couple travelled across the North American continent, winning friends everywhere with their kind and simple ways.

After her husband's death, the begum continued her efforts to wean the women of her country away from the ancient customs which keep them from public life. She introduced an all-Pakistan women's association and established a women's national guard, a voluntary organization which gives women military and nursing training.

Mrs. Ken Alder and children Donald and Mary-Margaret, 308 Ninth Avenue West, left last night aboard the Prince Rupert for Pitt Meadows, B.C., in the Fraser Valley, where they will visit the youngsters' grandparents, Mr. and Mrs. James Dibben.

Mrs. V. Basso-Bert, 354 Biggar Place, and her daughter, Mrs. Joe McKay, 1014 First Avenue West, also left last night aboard the Rupert, on a three-week holiday trip to Vancouver and Victoria.

"I had been planning it for a long time," she said in recalling her disappearance. "I couldn't stand that school, Egwood high school, any longer, and my folks wouldn't let me go to another one. I had saved \$70 and knew I was going to do it. I didn't even leave a note."

She changed her name and fled to Albuquerque where she met and married Air Force S. Sgt. Tom Cory, 23, who attended her church here.

Now a mother of six weeks, the 17-year-old Mrs. Cory says she "feels much better" since her deception is over.

She was recognized by Pittsburgh airman at the Sandia hospital where she was having her baby.

Mrs. Cory said she hadn't told her husband her real name until they had been married eight months.

"I was never homesick," Peggy Ann said. "I was so glad to be home and I was much too happy."

In Pittsburgh her parents Mr. and Mrs. Robert Hewston, were overjoyed. Tears streamed down Mrs. Hewston's face. Her husband, a steelworker, said:

"Thank God. We've prayed so much that Peggy would turn up safe. And to think she is married and has a baby. Why, that's just swell."
