## Credit Curbs Irritating But Needed To Avoid Inflation Says Bank Chief

TORONTO (C) — Credit restrictions are irritating and awkward for borrowers, but are necessary if inflation is to be avoided, John S. Proctor, president of the Imperial Bank of Canada, said today at the bank's annual meeting.

It was most important, he said, that the business community, as well as governments and individuals, should recognize their necessity to co-operate fully.

Attempted rates of capital expansion this year were much too great to be fully carried out, and high rates of interest were bound to continue unless current levels of investment spending were reduced.

Mr. Proctor added:

"Had the Bank of Canada prevented rising interest rates by increasing the supply of bank cash, thus keeping credit easy, this would not have avoided interruption of current projects and plans because interference with them would soon have appeared in the form of shortages of labor and supplies, resulting in rising costs and prices."

"If current rates of expansion are to be moderated, as they must, it is surely preferable that this should come about by restraint in the use of credit rather than by reducing the purchasing power of the currency.

Nevertheless, flexibility and understanding in such matters was necessary. Restraints should be eased as soon as there was evidence of sufficient reduction of demand to avoid danger of inflation.

In the first six months of 1956 the physical volume of national output was more than six per cent above 1955's first half.

In the light of the rate of expansion, it was not surprising that growing scarcities should tend to push prices up.

"The remarkable thing," said Mr. Proctor, "is that inflationary measures have been so mild and so long delayed.

"For this we have mainly to thank our ability to tap the productive capacity of the United States and other countries.

Imports of goods of all sorts have relieved the scarcities somewhat and made it possible for the production of capital goods and of consumer goods to increase together."

Despite the fact that Canadian savings were increasing, about 25 per cent of current investment came from imported capital. High as this percentage was, however, it was far short of the rate in the other great period of expansion before 1914.

Without this capital the rate

of expansion must necessarily have been slower and, at least in current circumstances, there would have been greater risk of inflation. Also, there was little evidence that foreign investors were using their control of large segments of Canadian industry to the detriment of the country.

"It would perhaps be healthy," Mr. Proctor added, "if Canadians were given more opportunity to participate in equity holdings of externally-controlled companies. But given due vigilance, we, as well as the foreign investor, gain by this movement of capital."

Lawyers here say the move is rarely used in Canada.
