

"Little Arthur" Willing To Take on All Comers

TORONTO Q -- As Arthur "Ike" Williams' receptionist, he was Ike Williams' lightweight champion at the time "L'il Arthur" headed for the U.S. with high hopes of grabbing the title. "Finally I got around to fighting welters for lack of lightweight competition. Now, Palermo has the world welter champion in Johnny Saxton. Where does that leave me?"

LOTS OF CONFIDENCE

For the time being, at least, King must come under the heading of a former top-ranking lightweight but his first challenge to the boxing fraternity in many months didn't lack in confidence.

"I'll take on any lightweight in the world," said "L'il Arthur," who has completed the circle since he joined Palermo in 1948. He reported his Palermo contract had been purchased by Max Orgoglio, the Toronto manager who sold it in the first place after getting him started as a pro in 1946.

The 27-year-old King said he hasn't fought in 16 months because of a hand injury. He said he fractured a bone in the little finger of his left hand in the third round of a 10-round fight he lost to Eddie Cravez in San Francisco.

Wooldridge Making Bid For Comeback

ST. PETERSBURG, Fla. (UPI) -- Floyd Wooldridge, who doctors didn't think would walk again after an automobile accident, is making a strong bid to land a place on St. Louis Cardinals' pitching staff.

The 26-year-old right-hander was considered one of the club's better prospects for the 1954 season but had to sit it out on the voluntary retirement list after the accident in November, 1953.

Wooldridge's right leg was broken in three places between the ankle and knee when a pickup truck he was driving ran down a steep embankment after a wheel came off. The cast came off six months later.

"It was then the doc said he had doubted at first that I would be able to walk," Wooldridge recalled Monday.

His arm has looked good so far for this spring. He allowed only four hits in five innings of an intra-squad game and since the grapefruit season opened has pitched six scoreless innings. One of those three-inning stints came against New York Yankees and the other Monday against Detroit's Tigers.
