Like any other crime, it sooner or later exacts a price from its perpetrator many times greater than the yalue of what is sought. Yet this lesson has gone guheeded.

The guilt of warmongers is further darkened by the directing of man's spiritual gifts towards a destructive end. Having been raised above the level of animals by superior endowments, humanity now abuses its skill by employing it to design weapons of death. This will never cease until higher reasoning dominates the instinct for war, and with it the fear

of war. To defend oneself, or to help in the defence of others, against acquisitive criminals is the only course to take even when the cause appears hopeless. Toldo anything less is an act of treachery as unforgivable as that of invasion itself. War is nourished by those willing to betray their country, and the invaders seek them out as eagerly as they marshal their own forces and strengthen their armament.


