

## Sweden Rushes Oil Rationing To Save Dwindling Supplies

STOCKHOLM (AP)—Sweden's government yesterday rushed plans to begin rationing oil to conserve dwindling supplies cut short by the Middle East crisis.

Sweden's Socialist government proposed:

- A total ban on use of private cars on weekends.
- Reduction by 30 to 50 per cent during the next 10 weeks of deliveries of fuel oil to industries and private homes.

The fuel oil restriction is expected to lower the temperature in oil-heated homes by an estimated 10 degrees during the icy Swedish winter.



## Industrial, Economical Growth of B.C. Shows Marked Acceleration During Last 12 Months

VICTORIA (AP)—Marked acceleration in all phases of B.C. industrial and economic growth during 1955 was noted in the annual report of the Provincial Labor department, just released.

Increased demand for basic materials pushed production to record levels in most industries while the urgent need for a greater output of commodities and durable goods forced a heavy program of new construction and expansion of existing facilities.

Population growth created records in construction through the need for more housing, schools, hospitals and commercial buildings.

The forest industries, led by the pulp and paper section, continued a series of "spectacular advances," with both primary and secondary phases of the industry recording increased payrolls and production figures compared with the 1954 totals.

Greatest single increase in payroll totals was seen in the construction industry, which recovered from a slump during 1954 to show a gain of more than \$18,000,000 during 1955.

### Evacuation Of St. Paul's Slated Sunday

VANCOUVER (AP)—Plans are being completed for the full-scale evacuation of St. Paul's hospital Sunday in the first practical test of hospital evacuation in event of atomic attack.

About 300 people will take part in the program, 100 of them representing actual patients.

Purpose of the evacuation—to a mobile hospital set up in Burnaby—is to allow study of the complexities which might arise in actual evacuation.

Said Dr. Gordon E. Prayer of Ottawa, chief medical consultant for the federal civil defence organization:

"Actually, it will be the first time such a demonstration has taken place anywhere in the free world."
