

## immers Guinea Pigs Survival Research

DON (Reuters) — More than men and women from the countries taking part in the national cross-channel race from France to England in August will act as guinea-pigs for an all-scientific research project.

The experiment is to discover effects on the human body of prolonged expenditure of energy in cold seas, with a view to applying the lessons learned to the benefit of shipwrecked or stricken down ocean. Particular attention will be paid to the fat distribution of the body, which is insulation against cold.

As competitors reach the English coast, whether under their own swimming power or by boat, they will be taken to a medical centre for a further examination.

The scientists will have men and women from widely different climates and ways of life to investigate as there are entrants from Mexico, Portugal, the United States, Syria, Lebanon, Egypt, Greece, Turkey, Malta, New Zealand, Denmark, India, England, Ireland and Scotland.

The scientific records obtained will be related to other findings in long-term research on survival at sea. The object is to discover the best equipment, clothing and methods for saving the lives of seamen forced to take to rafts or dinghies in the open sea.



## Dial Long Distance, Ask For Jamboree To Reach Scouts by Phone at Niagara

NIAGARA-ON-THE-LAKE, Ont.

—A telephone exchange will be established here to serve the mile-square tent camp that will house the eighth world Scout Jamboree this summer.

Appropriately named "Jamboree," the exchange will exist only for the 10 days—Aug. 18 to 28—when the Scouts will be in camp. It will then be dismantled.

About 10,000 teen-age boys and Scout leaders from about 50 countries are expected for the Jamboree. To accommodate them a temporary town will be set up on the camp site, an army training centre along the Niagara river near this town of 2,000 residents.

The temporary exchange, to be set up by the Bell Telephone Company of Canada, will be listed at every long distance centre on the continent. To reach the camp by telephone, a caller need

### BIG SWITCHBOARD

Telephone equipment will include a three-position switchboard equipped to handle up to 200 individual telephones and 30 trunk lines. There will be 20 public telephones and individual telephones at Scout headquarters, sub-camp headquarters, and the various service offices such as those for the hospital, campsite chaplain, police, transport and travel agencies. Operators at the long distance switchboard in St. Catharines will handle out-of-town calls.

The telephone company is also providing radio circuits for broadcasts from the camp, telephone facilities and mobile telephone unit to be stationed at the beach on nearby Lake Ontario while Scouts are swimming.

Manager of the Jamboree exchange will be J. B. "Critten" of Toronto.

Although Scouts will come from about 50 countries and will speak about a score of languages,


