Sixty-Six Dead
in Brief Battle

Montreal (CP) — National troops were concentrated at vital points about this South Vietnamese capital today after taking back an attack by a private army of American supporters of Premier Ngo Dinh Diem.

Sixty-six persons were killed and 112 wounded during which raged for four hours early this morning. French sources gave the total: National army, 56 dead, 31 wounded; rebels, 10 dead, 20 wounded; 10 dead, 58
