



OTTAWA (P)-Removal of the CBC from its "virtual monopoly" position was urged today before the royal commission on broadcasting by the Canadian Federation of Mayors and Municipali-

The federation-- representing elected officials in some 300 municipalities -- sald private broadcastors and the CBC should be placed on an equal basis under an independent regulatory!

It also declared privately-own-Montreal, Ottawa, Toronto, Winnipeg and Vancouver.




