

REVOKE: You revoke wh you full to follow suit although leble to do so. A revoke is established when the offender or his partner leads or plays to the next trick. Penalty: Two tricks, won after the revoke, are transferred to the non-offending side. EXPOSED CARDS: If you are

playing a hand as declarer no eard of yours ever becomes a penalty card. If you wish, you can spread your whole hand face up on the table - although frankly I can see no advantage But if a defender exposes a

eard or sees a card of his partper's before he should, that card becomes a penalty card and must be left face up and played at the first legal opportunity. LEAD FROM WRONG HAND I

BY DECLARER: If the lead is in the closed hand and declarer leads from dummy (or viceversa) he must, if required by a defender, lead from the propert hand and, if possible, he must LEAD OUT OR TURN BY


