

## Alberta Nimrods, Anglers Seeking Farmers As Friends

CALGARY 6—Hunters and fishermen here, as in other areas, want farmers for friends.

Fish and game associations in western Canada consistently try to educate members to respect farmers' rights and their land. Complaints have been registered in the past about some hunters' disrespect for farm property. A movement now starting caters to the farmers.

The Calgary Fish and Game Association has drafted a resolution to be forwarded to the Alberta legislature which would protect the rights of farmers.

**CLEAR POSTING**

The resolution asks that farmers be asked to post signs outlining the conditions under which sportsmen will be allowed to enter their land. Other provisions ask that the farmer post his name and registered number, entitling him to close the land to sportsmen at certain times of the year.

One fish and game group here has proposed that the club sign up for a \$10,000 public liability insurance policy to provide protection to farmers for property loss caused by sportsmen. Hunters would carry cards bearing their names and addresses. These would be given to farmers who give permission to hunt on their land.

George Spargo, manager of the Alberta Fish and Game Association, is one of the leaders in this hunter-education movement. The 61-year-old outdoors enthusiast has devoted much of his life to the welfare of the organization and the promotion of conservation.

Born in Polperro, Cornwall, England, Mr. Spargo started in conservation as assistant to the inspector of Alberta fisheries in 1921. He was director of fisheries when he resigned in 1940. He has been active in fish and game organizations since 1924.

## BLACKWOOD on BRIDGE

### Muzzy Draws Penalty With Premature Lead

Mr. Judge, the self-appointed arbiter of the game, is happiest when an argument comes up over an infraction of the rules. For that reason he likes to kibitz the table where Mr. Muzzy is playing. He gets plenty of action there.

You will notice all of the bidding is not given in today's hand.

Usually the actual play does not begin until a bid has been followed by three passes. Here it was different. Play began after Mr. Abel bid four hearts. Mr. Muzzy started it at this point by leading the ace of clubs.

Mr. Champion clapped his hands over his eyes. "Why does this sort of thing always happen to me?" he said in a strained voice. On the other hand, Mr. Dale and Mr. Abel both looked pleased.

### BOOK OF LAWS

The premature lead gave Mr. Dale the right to enforce a penalty. Mr. Judge whipped out his little book of laws and stated that the penalty was two-fold, as follows: First, Mr. Champion (partner of the offender) had to pass at his next turn. That wasn't so bad as he didn't want to bid any more anyway. He felt that four-spade contract played by Mr. Muzzy, might be pretty rough.

So the bidding reverted to where it had been so rudely interrupted and Mr. Abel's fourth heart bid was duly followed by three passes.

The second part of the penalty was that the ace of clubs became a "penalty card." It had to remain face up on the table and it had to be played the first time Mr. Muzzy could legally play it.

### AN ADVANTAGE

Mr. Champion's opening lead was the 10 of spades and when dummy went down, Mr. Dale saw at once the advantage he could realize from Mr. Muzzy's premature lead. He won the first trick with the ace of spades over Mr. Muzzy's king. He led the queen of hearts and Mr. Champion took the ace and returned the seven of diamonds. Dummy's ace won and Mr. Dale led a small heart to the jack. Then he led the ace of clubs and played the five from the board. Mr. Muzzy was forced by the laws to take this trick with the ace.

Had the hand been played normally, the defender could have won two clubs, the ace of hearts and a diamond trick.
