

> chance of getting cancer. The study was made by Dr. Douglas P. Murphy and associates under auspices of the University of Pennsylvania school of

medicine. They studied nearly 10,000 female relatives of women who had cancer and others who did not. The cancer patients had either cancer of the breasts or uterus, the two most common! sites of female cancer.

They did not find that cancer, in any sites in general, occurred with any unusual frequency in relatives of women who had cancer of the breast or uterus. And the relatives of women who had breast cancer hadn't more breast cancer than relatives of women free of that

They did find some statistical widence, not strong, that cancer of the uterus might be more common among relatives of women with uterine cancer.


