

Mr. Gunderson recently announced purchase in England of some 90 miles of steel rail for the government-owned Pacific Great Eastern Railway.

The apple order would mean about 750,000 boxes of No. 1 apples delivered to Britain, BC.'s apple crop this year is expected to be in excess of 5,000,000 boxes.




