Heavyweight Bout Seen Next On List

LONDON (AP)—Archie Moore today brushed aside all questions about another defence of his light-heavyweight title and said:

"I'm the best heavyweight in the world—and that's the title I am after."

The cagey old fellow from San Diego, Calif., cleared one big hurdle on the way to the crown vacated by Rocky Marciano with a round TKO of Yolande Pompey of Trinidad in a light-heavyweight title fight in London's Harringay Arena Tuesday.

"Now I want that heavyweight title," Moore said. "I'm entitled to it." Marciano nominated me as his logical successor. Floyd Patterson and Tommy Jackson are fighting Friday. There's talk

INSIDE BASEBALL for Little Leaguers




When giving signals to Little League players, the coach should not make them complicated. Nor should they be so simple that the opposing team can recognize them.

One of the favorite signals in professional baseball is the skin-to-skin sign. Any time a coach rubs his hands together, touches his hand against his face or forearm or any other bare skin on his body, the signal is on. One danger in using this sign is that an absent-minded coach might scratch an itch on his chin and find the batter bunting the next pitch when the coach wanted him to hit away.

Coaches often give several signals in a row to confuse their opponents. The players on the team will be told that they should follow the first signal given in the first inning, the second signal given in the second inning, etc. To keep from tipping off the signs to their foes, the players should continue to watch the coach until he completes his signaling.

Coaches can work out many varieties of signs from game to game, and from inning to inning. Generally the batters and base-runners indicate that they understand the sign by touching their web belts, rubbing a hand against the uniform or some other simple signal.

Equestrian Olympics Start Sunday

STOCKHOLM (AP)—Swedish riders have taken over the Olympic torch and today were speeding through the deep woods of southern Sweden to reach Stockholm in time for the opening ceremony of the Olympic equestrian games Sunday.






