CURLERS TO VIE FOR 6 TROPHIES

The recently completed \$80,000, six sheet curling rink on which curlers will vie for six trophies during the next five days, looks like a pennant-decked carnival.

Flags and decorations have been strung across the interior of the building and in the entrance hall, garters, sea photos, a map to remind curlers where they are, and even navigational instruments all bear an important role in playing up the atmosphere synonymous with "Marine."

The ice itself looks virgin and ready to face the onslaught of swishing brooms and sliding rocks.

The famous "snake room" which offers tired curlers a chance to recuperate, has recently undergone a facelift and extension to quarters previously occupied by lockers.

Lavish chesterfields surround the room and pictures of former curling conquerors adorn the walls.

Mayor To Declare Event Open

Official opening will take place tomorrow at 2 p.m. when Mayor George E. Hills extends the welcome of the city to visiting rinks.

Following the opening remarks all curlers will join in a grand march around the ice led by the brass band of the 120th Independent Field Battery RCA (M).

The mayor will then declare the Marine Bonspiel officially open by throwing the first rock. All rinks are guaranteed five games.

Rinks will vie for six competitions and will play under the revised Royal Caledonia Rules.

The six trophies are: The Grand Challenge donated by Fashion Footwear; the Second Primary, donated by North Star Bottling works; Secondary to the Second Primary, donated by E. E. Applewhite; the Consolation donated by Baron Fisheries and the Grand Aggregate donated by Prizewell Motors.

Players on the award winning rinks will each receive miniature trophies.

Curling club president, Bobby Rudderham today extended his heartfelt thanks to all those persons whose names are too numerous to be mentioned, who have contributed towards what he is sure will be "the most successful 'spiel held here yet."
