# Janan canada Global Final Goes 11 Innings

DETROIT (CP) — Japan won the global world baseball series title Wednesday night after being extended to 11 innings by the Canadian team they defeated 4-2.

It was the second defeat for Canada, represented by Edmon-1 ton Eskimos, during the eight days of play among eight nations at Briggs Stadium, home of Detroit Tigers. Their other defeat, in the opener last Friday, also was at the hands of the Japanese team.

The United States, holder of the title since the series was organized three years ago, was eliminated Tuesday by Canada.


