Percentages presented to District 52 School Board on Tuesday were: City: Booth Memorial High school enrollment 71.3 per cent; Conrad Street school 383-95.4 per cent; King Edward school 304-91.5 per cent; Roosevelt Park school 378-91 per cent; Port Edward school 218-90.8 per cent. Rural enrollment figures were: Port Essington 10, Digby Island 23 and Sunnyside 27.
