

CALYPSO SINGERS TOMORROW

Producer Hopes To Bring Top Shows To Prince Rupert Every Two Weeks

Ted Greenslade, of Vancouver's Cave Supper Club and producer of the Calypso Jamboree which opens here tomorrow night told The Rupert Daily News today that he plans bringing top shows from The Cave in the Rupert, Kitimat and Terrace areas every second week.

"All these shows," he states, "are AGVA acts straight from the bigtime night club circuits and will include stars who have played The Cave, Bimbos in San Francisco and the Sahara Hotel in Las Vegas. These acts will be flown to Terrace by CPA and will play there at the High School Auditorium on a Monday night."

"Along with the Calypso Jamboree I am bringing Charlie Aaron who starred in the Roadshow, 'Oklahoma,'" he said. "Mr. Aaron has also appeared in a

number of pictures. With Maureen O'Hara he was featured in 'Do You Love Me?'

"He was also featured in the 20th Century Fox presentation 'Kitten on the Keys.' He starred in 'Gas Light and Pink Tights' which was held over in Las Vegas for 16 weeks and set the all time record at Bimbo's 365 Club in San Francisco with top billing for 11 months."

"Whether shows of this type continue depends on the people of the area," Mr. Greenslade said. "If we get public support I can promise to bring in such names as the Deep River Boys, the Mills Bros., Sophie Tucker, Helen Boyce, Anne Weldon, Victor Perry, Marie MacDonald, The Jones Boys, The Four Coins, the Coronet Dancers, Meg Myles, Billie Daniels and countless others who are tied in with our circuit."

"It is my belief that the people of this area are ready for and want something better than the third rate acts which have frequently appeared here in the past."

"I hope this will be a permanent circuit and if it is we'll be happy to co-operate in any way with local civic and service organizations," he said.


