Although Forest Service fire fighting costs to May 3 are down Wallace's Dept. Store almost \$3,000 from last year's costs for the same period, there has been a total of 96 fires this year as against 70 in 1956, for the corresponding period

The Prince Rupert District has reported 13 of this total; the Prince George and Kamloops Districts, 28 fires each; the Nelson District, 23; and the high-value Vancouver District, which includes all of Vancouver Island, had reported 4 fires as at May 3.

After the 1956 Season, when more than 2,800 forest fires burned over 450,000 acres, Forest Service officials had hoped for relief this year.

LONDON (P) — Another of Princess Margaret's friends is off the "eligible" list.


Stuart, 31-year-old cousin of the Duke of Devonshire, has announced his engagement to Mrs. Cecile Tonge, 39, of Chelsea.




