BITS BLOWN FROM REGINA

Half a Column of Items Showing How Serious Have Been and Still Are Matters for the Citizens of the Stricken City

Hon. George H. Perley, acting premier, has been deluged with cablegrams from England, Scotland and Ireland, asking for details and names of any old country victims of the Regina disaster.

Special Assessment
It has been suggested that a special assessment should be levied upon the citizens at large to raise a million dollars or more if necessary in order that the ruined district may be rebuilt without delay.

C.P.R. Activities
Since the disaster the C. P. R. have had a large gang at work erecting new freight sheds, the operations being continued into the night, and the large temporary structure is now completed.

Good Business
The Dominion Express company has announced that it will carry free all shipments consigned to the relief committee at Regina.

Relief Fund Swells.
The relief fund is growing steadily. The Saskatchewan government has contributed \$25,000, Manitoba, \$10,000; Alberta, \$10,000; Edmonton, \$5,000; Winnipeg, \$5,000; Fort William, \$2,000; the C.P.R., \$5,000; the C.N.R., \$5,000; Lord Strathcona, \$1,000, and Mayor McEwen \$1,000.

Work for Hundreds
As the city is considering the erection of thousands of houses there will be any amount of work for all. The trades needed most are: Carpenters, bricklayers, electricians, plasterers and tinsmiths, although there is a dearth of all trades.

Threaten to Go to Regina
Winnipeg, July 8—If a settlement of the differences between the carpenters and employers, including the stationery engi-

neers, is not made by Friday, the men threaten to go to Regina.

How Many Affected?

A special committee of a hundred citizens have been engaged throughout the week, making a canvas of the citizens of the destroyed area with a view to having an official record of the people affected.

Estimating the Damage.
Another committee of contractors have been engaged in compiling an estimate of the damage done. With these statistics to work on, the authorities will be in a better position to make arrangements for the necessary financing required for rebuilding.

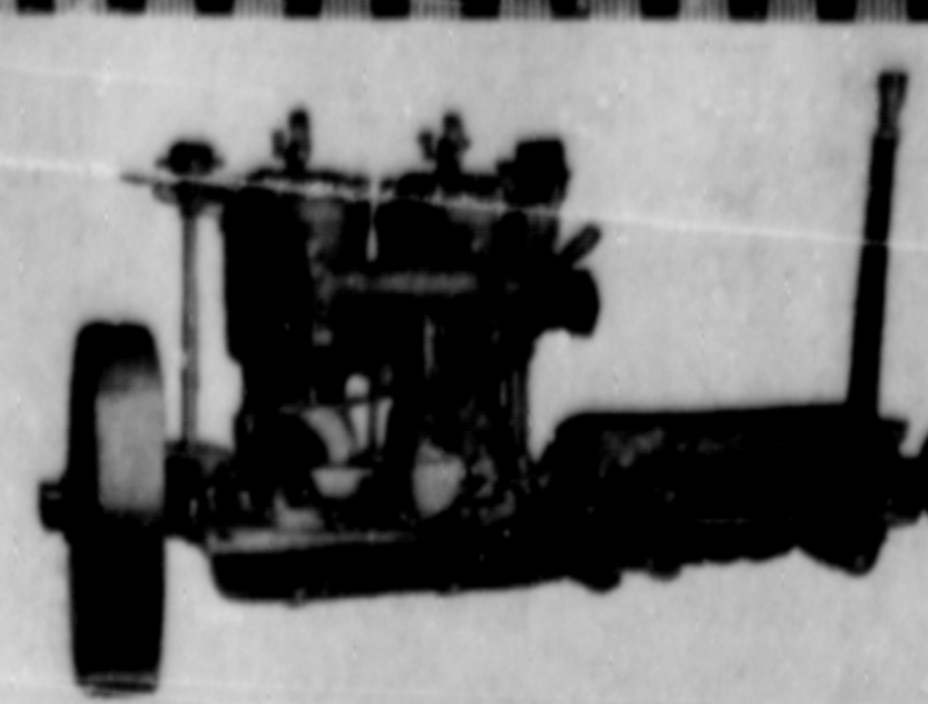
Kid Lucas Will Become Fireman and Live in Calgary.
