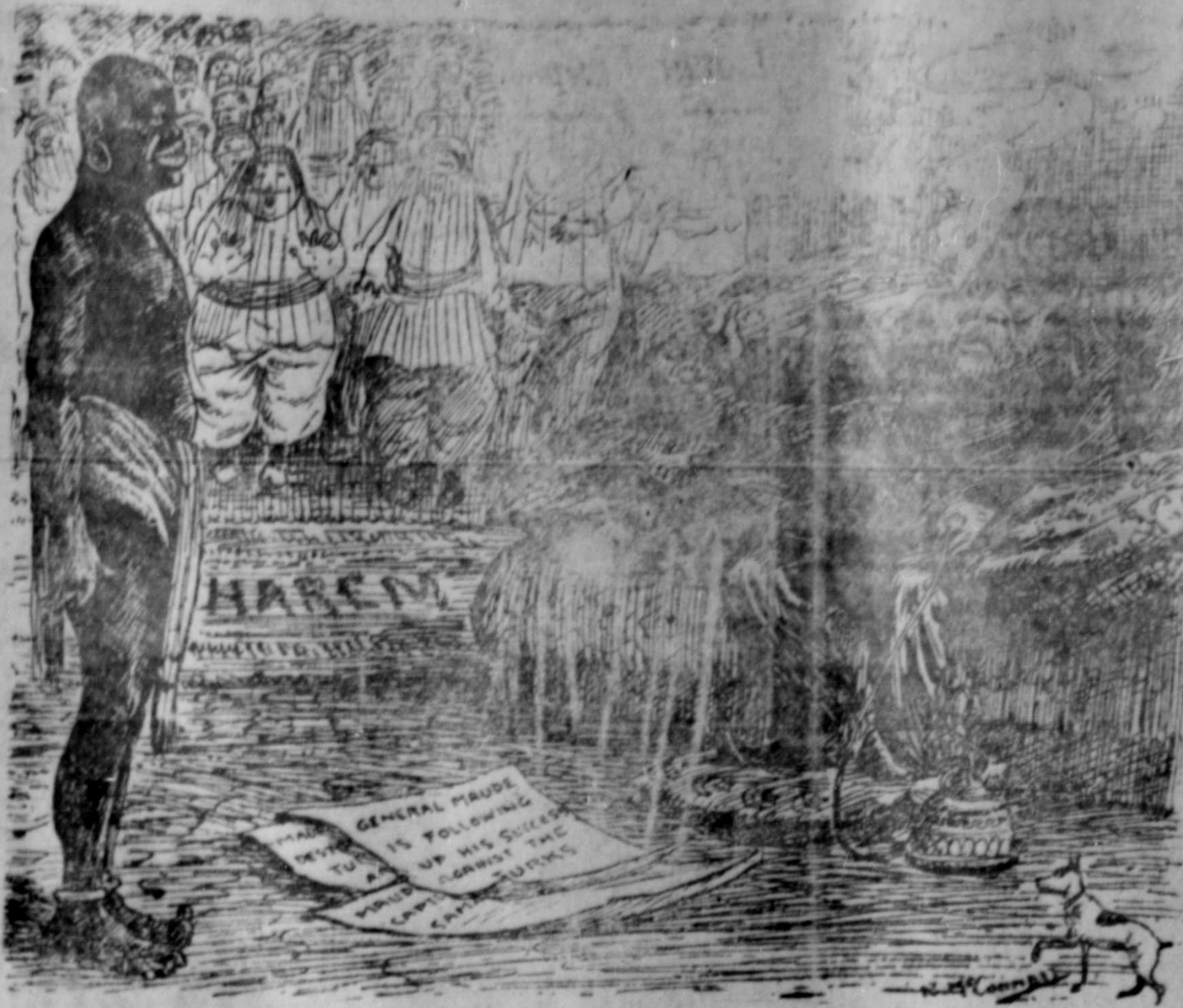

HINDENBURG AND U-BOAT SUPREMACY

News from Berlin sent through the wireless stations of the German Government includes the following: Hindenburg, in an interview with the representative of the Spanish newspaper "Vanguardia" stated, among other things:—

When unrestricted U-boat warfare was decided upon, in spite of the possibility of American assistance for the Entente, it was found that it was even too light. The American war supplies increased even at that time to such an extent that a further increase is not very well possible.

Even with the most intensive labor it will not be possible that an American expeditionary corps of any considerable size can be ready for embarkation to Europe before a year has passed.
