## ARE GENTLEMEN THAT IS OPINION OF REV. W. F. BARFOOT GIVEN IN ADDRESS TO ROTARY CLUB LEARNING LESSON OF FORCE RESPONSIBILITY OF CANADIANS TO **ORIENTALS URGED BY SPEAKER** WITH SOLEMN WARNING

MALAY PEOPLE

Either the Oriental will learn the lesson of force and emulate us in getting power by our methods or he will learn the higher lessons of tolerance and respect for others and understanding. In that lies a great responsibility with the white race, according to W. F. Barfoot, who addressed the Rotary Club yesterday on the People of the Malay Pensinsula.

Mr. Barfoot explained that the Peninsula was very important as having a very important British naval base at Singapore and also for its production of tin and rubber. Three quarters of the world's supply of tin comes from this pensinsula and over half of the rubber. It was not of this, however, he wished to speak. He was more interested in the people than in the commercial aspect of the country. KNOWING AND UNDERSTANDING The difficulty today was that people did not appreciate those of other colors or races as they should. It was only by knowing and understanding them that they could be appreciated. There were in the Straits Settlements approximately a million and a half Chinese, a million and a half native Malays and three quarters of a million laborers from India. Most of the wealthy people were Chinese but the rubber plantations are all owned in Europe and the Europeans in the country are therefore practically all salaried men. Mr. Barfoot told of the boom in rubber a few years ago when plantations which had no value were sold to innocent investors. As a rule shares in the good plantations could not be purchased as they were not for sale. UNIVERSITY OF EAST Most of the Chinese worked in the nines, the plantations were worked by natives from India. Both the Chinese and Indians returned to their homes in a few years and often could then live independently. While in the country the children were educated better than they would be even in England. These people returned to their homes with new sense of prosperity and independence, to inculcate the new idea into the people at home. Well were the Straits Settlements called the University of the East. The influence of the country was tremendous and even the Nationalist movement in Canton was
