The Ontario Election...

The Co-operative Commonwealth Federation, which had not a single seat in the last Ontario Legislature and polled only about five per cent of the total vote in the last general provincial election, emerges as a strong second in party strength following the election in that province yesterday. This is the notable feature of the results of the election. It is the greatest confirmation we have had to date of the marked swing to socialism that is occurring in Canada today. It will hearten Socialist politicians who envision the accession of their party to national power in Canada before long now. In any case socialism is definitely on the march towards political control of the Dominion and we may as well admit the fact here and now.

The Progressive-Conservative party under Col. George Drew, with some coalition or agreement with the Liberals, is apparently to form the new government in Ontario. A government by compromise, with no party having a clear majority, appears to be Ontario's present political due.

Nor is there much of the unexpected in the overwhelming defeat of Premier Harry Nixon's Liberal government which was without powerful leadership and more or less wracked with internal dissension in reaction to the regime of the fiery Mitchell Hepburn, whose re-election was a personal tribute.

All in all, the Ontario election results may be accepted as significant but they cannot be regarded as particularly surprising.
