

NATIONAL DEBT NOW TOTALS \$1,838,131,058

Excess of Revenue Over Expenditure Dwindled During December Month Compared with a Year Ago.

OTTAWA, Jan. 10 .- The excess of ordinary revenue over ordinary expenditure in December was only \$1,300,000. In December of last year the excess was \$12,000,000.
