Prince Rupert, B. C., Dec. 15. Editor News,

A great deal has been written in the Tory press, stating that if Laurier and the Liberals are returned to power at Ottawa, we shall have the French-Canadians dominating the rest of Canada. This, of course, is a foolish argument, but all the same, many people might at first believe the specious statements of the Tories, were there not facts to disprove such ridiculous sayings. Here are some facts.

At the time of the Boer war, who was Premier of Canada? Laurier.

Who was it that sent the Canadian contingents to the war against the wishes of his French supporters? Laurier.

Who was it that settled the Manitoba school question in a manner not at all satisfactory to his Church and his French supporters? Laurier.
